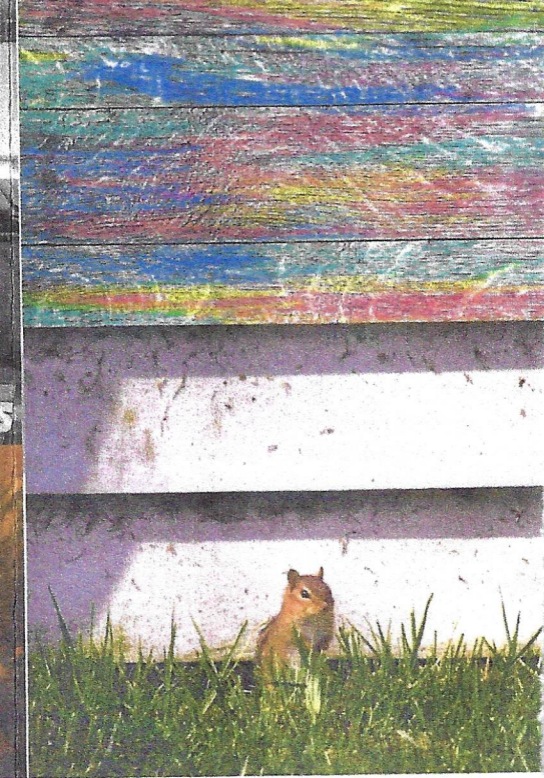

This sudden whirlwind has me in a daze.

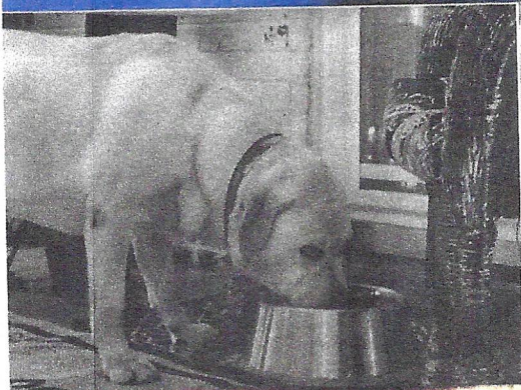
Pushed together by fate and irony,
